This report presents data at the community level regarding healthcare utilization rates for Medicare fee-for-service (FFS) patients as well as adverse drug events (ADEs) reported for hospital inpatients and emergency department (ED) visits.

Community Report Contents

- Health care utilization rates*
 - All cause hospital admission rates per 1,000 beneficiaries
 - All cause 30-day readmission rates per 1,000 beneficiaries
 - ADEs (adverse drug events) per 1,000 inpatient discharges among high risk beneficiaries**
 - ADEs per 1,000 emergency department visits among high risk beneficiaries
 - Community Tenure – days per year beneficiaries spend in their home setting
- Comparison to state averages
- Community goals
- Utilization for selected demographics and health conditions

** High risk defined as beneficiaries on 3 or more medications chronically including an anticoagulant, diabetes drug or opioid

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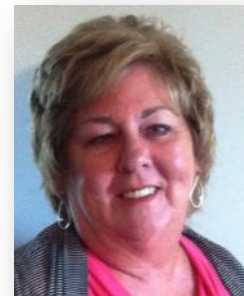
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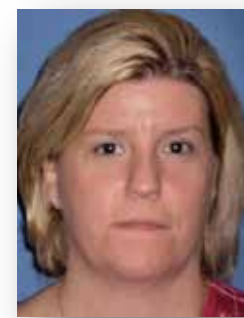
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
